

## **Hindi NLP Workshop Report**

Linguistic Data Consortium for Indian Languages (LDC-IL), Central Institute of Indian Languages (CIIL), Mysore in collaboration with Department of Linguistics, University of Lucknow, Lucknow organized a Training Programme on Natural Language Processing from October 25–29, 2013 at University of Lucknow, Lucknow. The programme started with the Inaugural Function on 25<sup>th</sup> Oct. 2013 at 10:00 am in the seminar hall at the Department of Linguistics, University of Lucknow, Lucknow. Prof. Awadesh kumar Mishra, Director, CIIL, Mysore, Dr. L. Ramamoorthy, Head LDC-IL, Mysore, Imtiyaz Husnain, HOD, Department of Linguistics, AMU, Aligarh, Prof. Kavita Rastogi, Head of the Department of Linguistics, University of Lucknow, Lucknow was the Chief Guest and the function was presided over by Prof. Awadesh kumar Mishra, Director, CIIL. Dr. Imtiyaz Husnain, HOD, Department of Linguistics, AMU, Aligarh, uttered the activities and the significance of NLP in the emerging areas of Applied Linguistics. Dr. L. Most of the lectures, systematic demonstrations, and hands-on practices were held in the seminar hall.

The Inaugural Function was followed by a series of expert lectures. A. Nandaraj Meetei, Lecturer/RP, LDC-IL, gave a series of talks on various aspects of Artificial Intelligence and Natural Language Processing focusing on Computational Grammar for Indian languages.

On the second day Ms. Atreyee Sharma, Senior Lecturer/JRO, LDC-IL, gave lectures on An Introduction to Text & Sign Corpus, Concept, Balancing & Classification, and providing the participants with the ideal tasks of LDC-IL team. As a second lecture, A. Nandaraj Meetei talked on Semantics (Theories of Meaning & Componential Analysis). On the last day, Dr. Arun Kumar Singh, JRP, LDC-IL, delivered lecture on morphological analyzer with a lot of hands-on practice on the tools and finally, Mr. A.Vadivel, Lecturer/RP, LDC-IL, gave lecture on LDC-IL In-house Corpus Tool.
