

Sub: Calling candidates for Short Term Goal Oriented Project for Maithili in LDC-IL Scheme, CIIL, Mysore

The Linguistic Data Consortium for Indian Languages (LDC-IL) scheme was established by the department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, GoI during XIth Plan period in the Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysore, Karnataka State. It has a mission to provide "Annotated, quality language data (both-text & speech) and tools in Indian Languages to Individuals, Institutions and Industry for Research & Development - Created in house, through outsourcing and acquisition".

LDC-IL is organizing a **Short Term Goal Oriented Project** for the **Maithili** language from **October 2022–March 2023** tentatively starting from **10/10/2022** to achieve the set targets of LDC-IL. It is suitable for candidates who have recently graduated and are looking for a short-term engagement in projects/schemes to enhance their knowledge and skills

Qualification and other details are listed below:

1. Educational Qualification & Eligibility:

- A Master degree/M.Phil/Ph.D in Maithili/Linguistics will be preferred.
- Basic Computer skills
- A native speaker of Maithili language with advanced reading, writing and speaking skills.

3. Nature of Work:

- Preparation of Speech Dataset in Maithili.
- Audio Segmentation using the suitable tools.
- Speech annotation of the given audio in the language given above.

4. Honorarium & Travelling Allowance:

- Honorarium @ Rs.1,000/- per each working day.
- TA @ 3AC for to-and-fro journey on production of the tickets.

5. Accommodation:

• Stay will be provided at SRLC Hostel (within CIIL campus) at nominal rates.

6. Terms and conditions:

- The Scholars applying for these positions should be willing to work for 45 working days without any break (except under unavoidable situations) during the STGOP.
- The candidates should have their own laptops (minimum configuration of Core 2 duo processor with 4 GB RAM and windows 7 & above) for the purpose of assigned work. Office space and internet connection will be provided.
- The candidates successfully shall complete the assigned work within a given deadline to be eligible for any honorarium.
- The period of the STGOP may be extended or reduced given the volume and nature of work, or due to any unforeseen reasons.
- Participation in such academic workshops is purely temporary and need-based in nature. It does not amount to any claim / favor / priority to any other position in the Schemes / Projects / Unit of the Institute.
